CLIENT RIGHTS

1. You have the right to expect that I have met the minimal qualifications of training and experience required by state law.
2. You have the right to inspect public records which contain my credentials maintained by the Minnesota Board of Psychology, 2829 University Avenue S.E., Minneapolis, Minnesota 55414-3237. (612-617-2230).
3. You have the right to obtain a copy of the rules of conduct from the Board of Psychology.
4. You have the right to report complaints to the Board of Psychology.
5. You have the right to be informed of the cost of professional services before receiving those services.
6. You have the right to privacy as defined by rule and law. (I am required by law to report instances of abuse or neglect of minor children or of vulnerable adults to the authorities. I am required by ethics to report cases of sexual contacts by a psychologist while you were in therapy. I am also required to take certain actions in cases of suspected suicide, homicide or other violent crimes.)
7. It is your right to be free from being the object of discrimination on the basis of race, religion, gender, or sexual orientation while receiving psychological services.
